Within the nine years Jessica and I have been matched, I have encountered a lot of problems with school and family," Little Sister Victoria told a room full of Big and Little Sisters at our May 16 Appreciation Breakfast. "My parents seemed to have trouble accepting who I was, which was a girl who didn't exactly do the best in school nor obediently listen to her mom and dad. This made it difficult for me to accept myself. My troubles lay in discovering my interests and core values and finding a balance between my happiness and my parents'."

The story that Little Sister Victoria told was ultimately one of overcoming adversity because someone believed in her. That someone was her Big Sister Jessica Reardon. "Today, I am still learning to accept my strengths and weaknesses," said Victoria. "And, it has been so much easier with my Big Sister by my side."

Victoria shared her college acceptance packet with her Big Sister during a trip to the Institute of Contemporary Art. "It made me cry, right there in the ICA – how hard she

had worked, the successes she had achieved, how mature and thoughtful she is, what a joy it is to be her mentor, how much she has still ahead of her," said Jessica. "And then it hit me, not for the first time, but in a new way: Victoria will always need a Big Sister."

And, indeed she does. As Victoria prepared to leave for college this fall, she faced yet another hurdle: Her parents were unable to drive her to Colgate University in upstate New York. When Victoria told Jessica about her dilemma, her Big Sister had her back just as she had for the past nine years. Jessica drove Victoria and Victoria's parents to Hamilton, New York where Victoria proudly showed off her new home.

This fall, Victoria joined the 90% of Little Sisters who enroll in college. Her fellow not-so-Little Sisters will be attending a range of institutions this year – from UMass Dartmouth to Mass Art. And, no matter where they go, they will all know they got there because a Big Sister believed they could, giving them the power to believe it too.

The office itself allows us to work more collaboratively, with a big, open floor plan, break-out areas, and a large conference room where we lead trainings and workshops.

We are proud to invite our community here, a place that truly reflects our mission and allows us to work more efficiently and effectively than ever.


Summer Sensation


Well before pop icon Taylor Swift made 2015 the "summer of the squad" by celebrating her close-knit female friendships, the Boykins Little Sisters and their Big Sisters had already formed the Boykins Crew with the help of Big Sister Boston. Swift's squad may consist of several super models, but the Boykins Crew is made up of role models.

Just who are the Boykins Crew? They are six biological sisters living in Dorchester. being raised by mom Terkeshia. Five of the sisters have each been matched with a Big Sister through our Community-Based, one-to-one mentoring program where Big and Little Sisters meet at a time and place of their choosing. The youngest Boykins, Ti-Ny, is eagerly awaiting her seventh birthday so that she too can be matched with a Big Sister.

Seven years ago, with a house full of growing girls, Terkeshia realized that she could use some support in giving her daughters the individual attention and nurturing they needed to thrive. She turned to Big Sister Boston for help. During the following years, we matched each daughter with a Big Sister based on their individual personalities and interests. Athletic Takia was matched with sportsenthusiast Tiffany, and together they've enjoyed spending one-on-one time on and off the basketball court. Goofy and gastronomically-inclined Tay-onna was matched with Big Sister Lisa who brings out Tay-onna's silly side in the kitchen as they experiment with recipes for cakes and cookies. "They have the perfect match, all of them," said mom Terkeshia, adding how much she appreciates the ways in which

each Big Sister allows her Little Sister the space to be herself and explore her own unique interests.

Recently, the crew was put to the test when two of the Big Sisters had to move away from Boston. Though they will no longer officially be matched through our program, they will always be a part of this special family that they helped build. Choking back tears, Terkeshia shared her gratitude for the role the Big Sisters have played in her daughters' lives: "It's like a whole other world that we live in with the Big Sisters coming and taking the girls out. I don't have to worry for those three to four hours that they're gone. I know everything's ok. This program has given me wonderful women who take time out of their schedules and make it their obligation to spend time with my girls, and I'm just forever grateful that they're part of my kids' lives."
